**EMERGENCY ORDINANCE**

An Emergency Ordinance to appropriate the Town of Fairmount Heights Budget for Fiscal Year 2001-2002.

**WHEREAS**, the Mayor has presented to the Town Council the annual budget for fiscal year 2001-2002; and

**WHEREAS**, the Town Council has discussed the budget with the Administration and has made further recommendations; and

**WHEREAS**, the proposed budget was advertised in a newspaper of general circulation on June 4, 2001, and a Public Hearing held June 19, 2001.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED**, by the Mayor and Town Council of Fairmount Heights sitting in regular session this 20<sup>th</sup> day of June 2001, as follows:

1. The property tax assessment as per Prince George's County property tax assessment per owner shall be \$.75 per \$100.00 of assessed property for land and improvements.
2. The Mayor's Budget message and all other detailed narrative presented by the Mayor and Council shall be considered a part of this Emergency Ordinance.
