**ORDINANCE**

Of the Town of Fairmount Heights, Maryland, Amending CHAPTER IV, PUBLIC MAINTENANCE AND THE ENVIRONMENT, Article 1, Solid Waste, of the Town Code of Ordinances.

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Article 23A of the Annotated Code of Maryland, the Town of Fairmount Heights has the authority to establish parking regulations, and to pass such ordinances as it deems necessary to protect and preserve the municipality's rights, property and privileges, to secure persons and property from danger and destruction to protect the health, comfort and convenience of the citizens of the Town; and

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to this authority the Town enacted Chapter IV "Public Maintenance and the Environment" of the Town Code of Ordinances; and

**WHEREAS**, upon review of Chapter IV, "Public Maintenance and the Environment" of the Town of Code of Ordinances, the Town Council has determined that it would be in the Town's best interest to amend Article I Solid Waste and add a penalty provision for violations.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED**, by the Town Council of the Town of Fairmount Heights, Maryland that the indicated sections of Chapter IV, "Public Maintenance and the Environment" of the Town Code of Ordinances be and is hereby amended to read as follows:

§ 4-101. Definitions

- (d) "Refuse" means all putrescible and non-putrescible solid waste (except body wastes), including garbage, rubbish, ashes, street cleaning, dead animals, abandoned automobiles, **AUTOMOBILE PARTS, INCLUDING TIRES** and solid market and industrial wastes.

50 **VIOLATION OF ANY PROVISION OF THIS ARTICLE SHALL CONSTITUTE A**  
51 **MUNICIPAL INFRACTION AND SHALL BE PUNISHABLE BY A FINE OF FIVE**  
52 **HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$500.00) PER VIOLATION PAYABLE TO THE**  
53 **MUNICIPALITY BY THE PERSON CHARGED IN THE CITATION WITHIN**  
54 **FIFTEEN (15) DAYS OF THE SUMMONS.**

56 **BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED AND ENACTED** that the following “No Littering”  
57 “\$500 Fine” signs be posted at the following locations:

59 1. Front and rear of the former Municipal Center, located 719-60th Place;  
60 2. In the alley way between 508 and 510 62<sup>nd</sup> Avenue  
61 3. Corner of Jost Street and Balsamtree  
62 4. In the public right-of-way near 6200 Field Place  
63 5. In the public right-of-way near 706-58th Avenue  
64 6. In the public right-of-way near the corner of 61<sup>st</sup> Avenue and Eastern Avenue  
65 7. In the public right-of-way near 5612 Jay Street
