10 EMERGENCY ORDINANCE
11

12 Of the Town Council Amending Chapter V, Vehicles and Traffic, Article 2, Stopping, Standing
13 and Parking, Section 5-209. Citations and Penalties of the Town Code of Ordinances, and
14 Adopting a Fine Structure for Parking Violations.

16 WHEREAS, pursuant to Article 23A of the Annotated Code Of Maryland, the Town of
17 Fairmount Heights has the authority to establish parking regulations, and to pass such Ordinances
18 as it deems necessary to protect and preserve the municipality's rights, property and privileges, to
19 secure persons and property from danger and destruction to protect the health, comfort and
20 convenience of the citizens of the Town; and

22 WHEREAS, the Fairmount Heights Police Department has recommended the adoption of
23 Prince George's County Fine Structure for parking violations.
24

25 NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED, by the Town Council of
26 Fairmount Heights, Maryland this 15th day of November, 2000 that Chapter V, Vehicles and
27 Traffic, Article 2. Stopping, Standing and Parking, Section 5-209. Citations and Penalties (A) is
28 hereby amended as follows:

30 With reference to the violation of parking regulations enunciated in this Article, a police officer
31 shall be duly authorized to issue to the owner or operator of a vehicle or by attaching to the
32 vehicle in question a notice of violation or failure to comply with the provisions of this Article.
33 The fine for parking violations shall be [fifty Dollars (\$50.00) if not paid not later than (5) days
34 following the issuance of said notice and One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) if paid after five (5)
35 days, but not later than fifteen (15) days thereafter. After fifteen (15) days a maximum fine of
36 Two Hundred Dollars (\$200.00) will be charged.] ACCORDING TO THE DESCRIPTION,
37 REFERENCE NUMBER AND FINE AMOUNT AS INDICATED ON THE PARKING
38 AUTHORITY OF PRINCE GEORGE'S COUNTY VIOLATION TABLE. FINES WILL
39 DOUBLE THE ORIGINAL AMOUNT OF THE CITATION IF NOT PAID WITHIN
40 FIFTEEN (15) DAYS, AND WILL RE-DOUBLE THE ORIGINAL CITATION AMOUNT
41 IF NOT PAID WITHIN FIFTEEN (15) DAYS THEREAFTER.
42

43 This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon passage by the Town Council. The attached
44 Parking Authority of Prince George's County VIOLATION TABLE shall become the Parking
45 Authority of the Town of Fairmount Heights VIOLATION TABLE.


