Of the Town Council of the Town of Fairmount Heights, Maryland Supporting the Old Town Hall Renovation Project To Improve the Safety and Well-being of the Community Through The Elimination of Spot Blight.

WHEREAS, the Town of Fairmount Heights is located in a Central Prince George's County revitalized area; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Fairmount Heights desires to meet one of the three National Objectives for the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) PROGRAM, i.e., to prevent or eliminate slums or blight; and


WHEREAS, the Town of Fairmount Heights has identified the Old Town Hall Renovation Project, which is a Public Facilities Project, as addressing conditions of slum or blight, that meets Priority Four of Prince George's County Community Development Project, Acquisition, Clearance and Demolition of properties to eliminate spot blight.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, this 27th day of September, 2000 as follows:

1. The Town is committed to support this project.
2. The project is scheduled to begin July 1, 2001 and be completed within one (1) year, on or before June 30, 2002.
3. The Town has the ability to administer this project and supervise contracted services.
4. The Town understands that it must use its own funds first and then be reimbursed by the CDBG program.
5. This Resolution shall become effective upon the approval by the Mayor and Town Council.




