RESOLUTION

Of the Town Council of the Town of Fairmount Heights, Maryland Authorizing the Installation of No Parking/No Standing Signs on 60th Avenue, and Parking By Permit Only on Balsamtree.

WHEREAS, the Charter of the Town of Fairmount Heights, Chapter V, Vehicles and Traffic, Article 2. Stopping, Standing, and Parking, Section 5-202. Traffic Control and Parking Restriction Signs (a) states: Whenever, in the judgment of the Mayor and Council, it shall be necessary for the safety or control of vehicular or pedestrian traffic or for the regulation of the use of parking areas, said Mayor and Council may direct the erection of "Stop", "No Parking", "Speed Limit", "One Way", and other traffic control devices and parking restriction signs designed to control, regulate, warn, or guide traffic or limit parking on public streets, highways or other public areas in the Town; and

WHEREAS, the Departments of Public Safety (Police) and Public Works have determined that 60th Avenue in the Town of Fairmount Heights, between the streets of Sheriff Road and Lee Place is too narrow for the safe passage of School Busses and other commercial vehicles including the Town Refuse Truck when cars are parked on the East and West sides of the street; and

WHEREAS, the Departments of Public Safety (Police) and Public Works have determined that the West side of the 1000 block of Balsamtree needs parking restrictions due to limited parking available to the residents; and

WHEREAS, based on the recommendation of the Departments of Public Safety and Public Works, the Town Council has determined that restricting parking on the East and West sides of 60th Avenue between Sheriff Road and Lee Place, and the West side of Balsamtree between L Street and Kolb Street would be in the best interest and safety of the Citizens of the Town.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, this 27th day of September, 2000 as follows:

1. Parking shall be permitted on the East side of 60th Avenue traveling North.
2. No Parking shall be permitted on the West Side of 60th Avenue. Three (3) No Parking/No Standing Signs shall be installed on the West side of 60th Avenue traveling South.

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
- 3. Parking by Permit Only shall be permitted on the West side of the 1000 block of Balsamtree between L Street and Kolb Street.
- 4. Two (2) Parking By Permit Only signs shall be installed on the West side of Balsamtree between L Street and Kolb Street.
- 5. A thirty (30) day notice shall be forwarded to all citizens informing them of the impending changes to the 1100 block of 60th Avenue and the 1000 block of Balsamtree.
- 6. A Map of the area is attached and shall be included as a pertinent part of this Resolution.
- 7. This Resolution shall take effect on October 27, 2000, or thirty (30) days following approval by the Mayor and Council.






