RESOLUTION

Of the Town Council of the Town of Fairmount Heights, Maryland Opposing the Special Exception Request (SE-4396) of the Rollins Recycling Center.

WHEREAS, Rollins Recycling Center has requested an exemption to build and install a transfer station in Beaver Heights, Maryland; and

WHEREAS, there is sufficient evidence to support opposition to this request, including the location which is in a Natural Reserve Area likely due to the flood plain of Beaver Dam Creek; and


WHEREAS, the Special Exception Site Plan proposed the relocation of a sanitary sewer easement outside the area of the special exception; and

WHEREAS, there have been recommendations to the Zoning Section of the Maryland-National Capital Park and Planning Commission to deny the Special Exception request.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, this 19th day of December, 2001 as follows:


1. The Mayor and Town Council are opposed to the creation establishment, Development, or construction of the Rollins Recycling Center or any other Transfer Station, on the proposed site in Beaver Heights, Prince George's County, Maryland.
2. The Mayor and Town Council feel that Prince George's County has more than a proportionate share of recycling/trash transfer stations in the Central Prince George's County area.
3. It is the opinion of the Mayor and Town Council of the Town of Fairmount Heights, that many of the questions that have been raised through internal memorandums to Zoning staff at Maryland-National Capital Park and Planning Commission, have not been thoroughly reviewed nor responded to.
