RESOLUTION

Of the Town Council of the Town of Fairmount Heights, Maryland Authorizing the Purchase of Two (2) Police Vehicles.

WHEREAS, the Town of Fairmount Police Department has requested permission to purchase two (2) police vehicles, and has obtained three (3) estimates to determine the best purchase price; and

WHEREAS, the payment for the police vehicles will be deferred until November of 2002; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Fairmount Heights Police Department has obtained three estimates for the cost of repairs to the Town's current fleet, the lowest of which is \$6,000.00.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, this 19th day of December, 2001 as follows:

1. The Mayor and Town Council authorized to enter into contract negotiations with Bob Tomes Ford for the purchase of two police vehicles.
2. The total cost to the Town over a three (3) Year period under the Optional Lease /Purchase Option is \$51,462 with three annual payments of \$17,154.00; for 36 monthly installments, the total cost is \$53,784; for 48 monthly installments the total cost is \$55,392.
3. The deferred payment cost in November, 2002 is \$17,154.00
4. This Resolution shall take effect upon passage by the Mayor and Town Council.
