RESOLUTION

Of the Mayor and Town Council of Fairmount Heights Approving the “Community Legacy Area”

Resolution of The Town of Fairmount Heights approving the Town of Fairmount Heights and the City of Seat Pleasant as designated Community Legacy Areas and application and receipt of financing for a Community Legacy Plan and Community Legacy Project(s) in the incorporated areas of the Town of Fairmount Heights and the City of Seat Pleasant, Maryland to be financed either directly by the Department of Housing and Community Development (the “Department”) of the State of Maryland or through other departments or agencies of the State of Maryland.

WHEREAS, the Town of Fairmount Heights recognizes that there is a significant need for reinvestment and revitalization of the communities in Prince George’s County; and,

WHEREAS, The Town of Fairmount Heights proposes to (i) designate the areas of the Town of Fairmount Heights and the City of Seat Pleasant in Prince George’s County, as outlined on the attached map (the “area”), the purpose of which will be to contribute to the reinvestment and revitalization in the Area; and,

WHEREAS, the Department, either through the community Legacy Program or through other Programs of the Department, or in cooperation with other state departments or agencies, may provide some or all of the financing of the Project (the “Project Financing”) in order to assist in making it financially feasible; and

WHEREAS, the applicable law, regulations and Departmental requirements necessitate approval of the Community Legacy Area designation, the Project and the Project Financing by The Town of Fairmount Heights and the City of Seat Pleasant and, where appropriate, by the Chief Elected Executive Official of the local subdivision;


NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT The Town of Fairmount Heights hereby endorses the designation of a Community Legacy Area and the Project in the Area; and, HEREBY approves the Project Financing in the form of a grant or loan in the appropriate amount of \$ _____; and
