RESOLUTION

Of the Mayor and Town Council of the Town of Fairmount Heights, Maryland Authorizing The Installation of a Three-Way Stop Sign at the Intersection of 56th Avenue and Kolb Streets.

WHEREAS, The Code of Ordinances of the Town of Fairmount Heights, Article 2. Section 5-202. Traffic Control and Parking Restriction Signs (a) states, **whenever, in the judgment of the Mayor and Council, it shall be necessary for the safety or control of vehicular or pedestrian traffic or for the regulation of the use of parking areas, said Mayor and Council may direct the erection of "stop", "No Parking", "Speed Limit", "One Way", and other traffic control devices and parking restriction signs designed to control, regulate, warn or guide traffic or limit parking on public streets, highways or to her public areas in the Town; and**

WHEREAS, it has been brought to the attention of Council that speeding is a problem as the intersection of 56th Avenue and Kolb streets and that a serious accident occurred at this intersection involving a vehicle and a pedestrian.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THIS 17th Day of April, 2002 as follows:

1. A Three-way stop sign shall be installed at the intersection of 56th Avenue and Kolb Streets to control the flow and traffic and deter speeding.
2. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon passage by the Mayor and Town Council.


