RESOLUTION

Of the Mayor and Town Council of the Town of Fairmount Heights, Maryland Authorizing A Formal Town Policy That Establishes Guidelines for the Approval of All Grants.

WHEREAS, Charter Amendment Resolution C-1-98 of the Town of Fairmount Heights Charter, Section 1-10. Quorum, **POWERS AND DUTIES, C.** states **“THE COUNCIL SHALL HAVE COMPLETE SUPERVISION OVER THE EXPENDITURES, INCOME AND INVESTMENTS OF THE TOWN AND MAY APPOINT SUCH FINANCIAL OFFICER, ANSWERABLE TO THE COUNCIL TO ADMINISTER THE EXPENDITURES, INCOME AND INVESTMENTS OF THE TOWN;** and

WHEREAS, the Town has received in the past, and expects to continue receiving Federal, State and Local funds as grant revenue in support of projects that improves the quality of life for the citizenry of the Town of Fairmount Heights; and

WHEREAS, in order to have complete control of the expenditures, income and investments of the Town, the Council shall have the authority to approve all grant revenue.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THIS 17th Day of April, 2002 as follows:

1. No citizen, organization, group, entity, or likewise, can solicit funds, grants, or other revenue on behalf of the Town, or represent the Town of Fairmount Heights without the prior approval of the Council.
2. Council shall prioritize projects and determine those who are to directly benefit from the scope of services as defined in the grant agreement.
3. A copy of all grants accepted by the Council shall be on file in the Administration and Treasurer’s office.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT THIS RESOLUTION IS ADOPTED TO PROTECT THE RIGHTS OF THE CITIZENS AND THE TOWN OF FAIRMOUNT HEIGHTS.






