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10 RESOLUTION

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13 Of the Town of Fairmount Heights, Maryland approving the Fairmount Heights Community
14 Legacy Plan and application and receipt of financing for a Community Legacy Project in
15 Fairmount Heights, Maryland, to be financed either directly by the Department of Housing and
16 Community Development (the "Department") of the State of Maryland or through other
17 departments or agencies of the State of Maryland.
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19 WHEREAS, Town of Fairmount Heights recognizes that there is a significant need for
20 reinvestment and revitalization of the communities in Prince George's County; and,
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22 WHEREAS, Town of Fairmount Heights proposes to (i) designate the area of the
23 municipality of Fairmount Heights in Prince George's County as outlined on the attached map
24 (the "Area") as a Community Legacy Area and to (ii) develop a Community Legacy Project (the
25 "Project") in the Area, the purpose of which will be to contribute to the reinvestment and
26 revitalization in the Area; and,
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28 WHEREAS, the Department, either through Community Legacy or through other
29 Programs of the Department, or in cooperation with other State departments or agencies, may
30 provide some or all of the financing for the Project (the "Project Financing") in order to assist in
31 making it financially feasible; and,
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33 WHEREAS, the Area is located within a priority funding area under Section 5-7B-02 of
34 the Smart Growth Act and the Project will conform to the local zoning code; and,
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36 WHEREAS, the applicable law and regulations require approval of the Community
37 Legacy Area designation, the Project and the Project Financing by Town of Fairmount Heights
38 and where appropriate, by the chief elected executive official of the local subdivision;
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40 NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT Town of Fairmount Heights hereby
41 endorses the designation of the Community Legacy Area and the Project in the Area; and,
42 HEREBY approves the request in the form of a grant, loan, or other financial vehicle in the
43 approximate amount of \$262,400.00; and,
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46 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT**, the chief elected executive official be, and is
47 hereby requested to endorse this Resolution, thereby indicating her approval thereof; and,
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
49 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT**, Lillie Thompson-Martin, Mayor is hereby

55 for consideration by the Community Legacy Board.
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

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


