


SECTION 5. Based on the input received at a public hearing, if one is requested and the results of their deliberations, the Town Council shall give at least 20 days public notice of whether the ownership of certain "paper" alleyways and streets will be conveyed to owners of adjacent properties; such public notice to include publication of a notice in a newspaper of general circulation in the Town.

SECTION 6. In accordance with Section 1-12 of the Town Charter, this Resolution shall become effective twenty (20) days after its passage.


