**RESOLUTION**

**A Resolution Authorizing Sale or Disposal of Excess Police Vehicles**

**WHEREAS**, the purchase of new vehicles has provided the Town the opportunity to sell or otherwise dispose of excess and damaged police vehicles; and

**WHEREAS**, the new transmission in one 2001 Ford can be placed in the vehicle with the new engine and be held in reserve for use by the Police Department, but also be used by the Mayor, Council members and the Town's senior staff for official business.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF FAIRMOUNT HEIGHTS THAT:**

**SECTION 1.** The Police Department will arrange for removal of police decals from all excess vehicles and work with the Town Manager and/or treasurer to complete the sale or disposal of the excess vehicles.

**SECTION 2.** Funds realized from the sale or disposal of excess police cars will be used to defray the costs of repairs to the "01 Ford in best shape. Any excess funds will revert to the General Fund and be available to defray Police Department related expenses.

**SECTION 3.** The Chief of Police or Acting Chief in the absence of the Chief and the Town Clerk will keep and secure a spare set of keys for each car.


**SECTION 4.** Whenever the repaired 2001 Ford is used by staff other than members of the Police Department: (1) in no case will emergency lights, loudspeakers, radios or other equipment be employed for any reason; (2) the Town's Safety Policy, the speed limit and all traffic laws and regulations will be observed at all times; and (3) the use of the vehicle will be recorded in the Use and Maintenance log.


